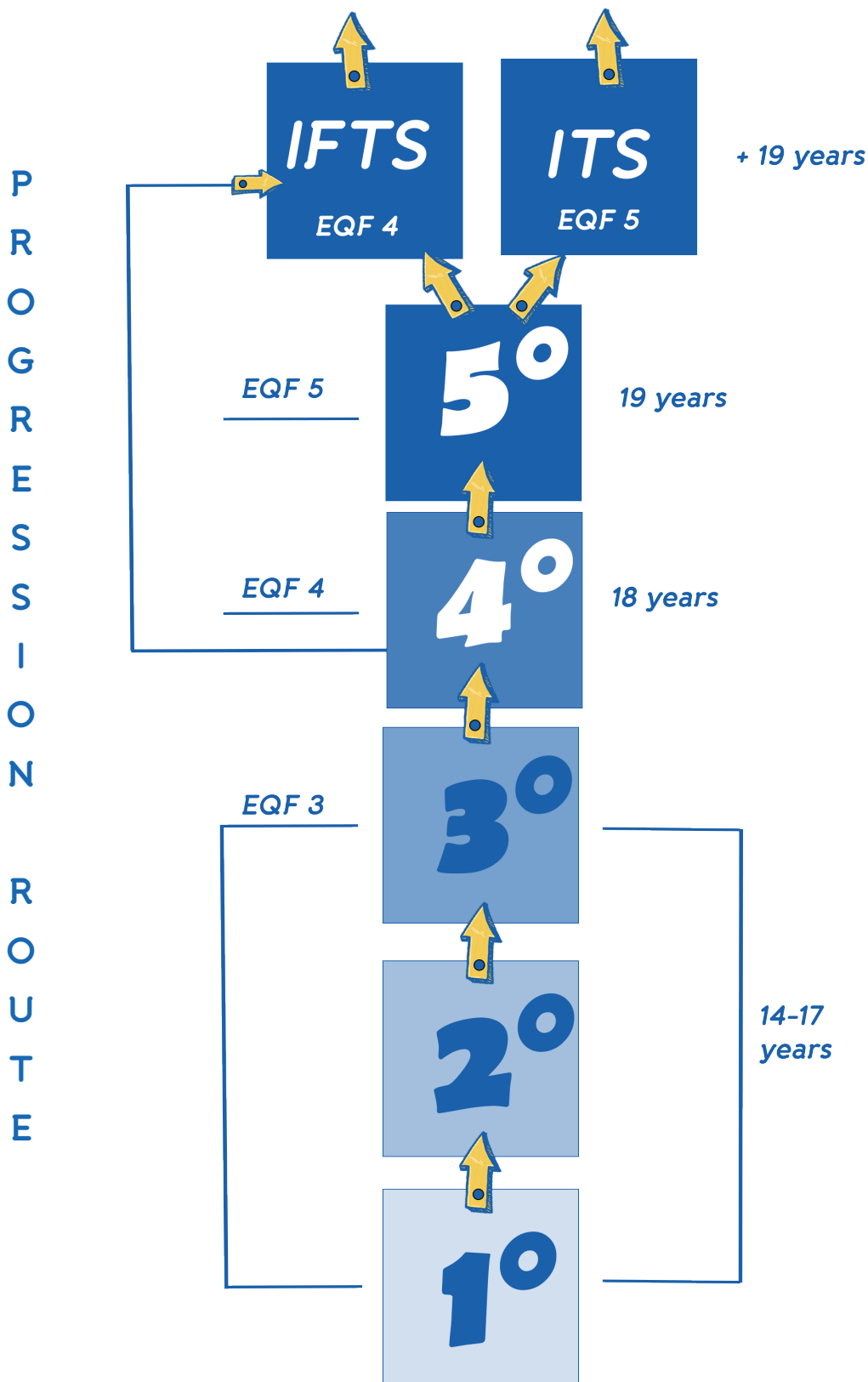

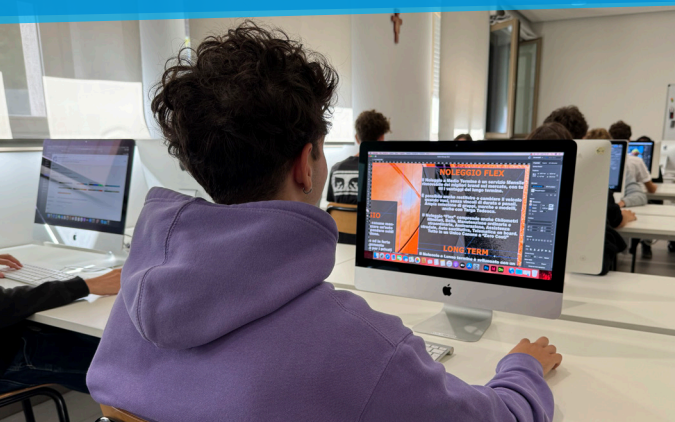

# OUR METHOD

## LEARNING BY DOING



The Canossian VET centres adopt a pedagogical approach that promotes the person, taking into account student aptitudes and aspirations (Learner-Centered Pedagogy).

Learning activities are designed based on defined learning outcomes and different Work Based Learning approaches are adopted.

Some examples:

1. **DUAL SYSTEM:** training centre and company join forces to co-design and implement a training course for the trainee. A full synergy, with common objectives.
2. **SCHOOL-BASED ENTERPRISE:** is a hands-on learning environment and an entrepreneurial operation located in a school setting. In this learning approach learners manage real business enterprises that allow them to acquire an entrepreneurial attitude which is useful to make conscious future educational and professional choices.
3. **PROJECT BASED LEARNING:** this is a teaching methodology in which students acquire knowledge and skills by working for an extended period of time on researching and solving a problem, an issue, a challenge, that is authentic, engaging and complex.
4. **SCHOOL-WORK ALTERNANCE:** the learner is enrolled in a training course involving periods spent in a company with specific training objectives.
5. **PROJECT WORK:** is a methodology where learners can experience independence in planning and realizing the work assigned and teachers act as a driver in ensuring it is carried out in a way that meets learning aims.

In the 2014-2020 programming period ENAC had obtained the Erasmus + **VET Mobility Charter certification**, renewed for the 2021-2027 period, obtaining the Erasmus + Accreditation for Education and Professional Training.

Erasmus + Accreditation is the most authoritative certification issued only to entities that offer quality mobility educational activities. Stable access to finance allows you to focus on long-term goals and increase the European dimension and the quality of mobility. ENAC also supports the consortium of Canossian Schools that have obtained Erasmus + Accreditation for School Education.
